I. Be relentless with sanitation:

Insist on relentless sanitaion habits and minimize plant stress.

2. Carefully hydrate, give space and air:

Water plants early, minimize overhead irrigation and splashing; provide good air circulation and adequate plant spacing.

3. Scout continuously for disease:

Continuously scout for diseased/dying plant tissue; discard in a sealed bag away from the greenhouse. Sanitize tools!

4 Prevention is the best cure:
